



How does my child qualify for ESOL?

At registration, if the home language survey indicates that a language other than English is spoken in the home, the ESOL teacher will administer the WIDA ACCESS Placement Test for Kindergarten or WIDA Screener (1st-12th graders).

WHAT DOES THE WIDA SCREENER/WIDA ACCESS MEASURE?

- IT IS USED TO MEASURE THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY OF STUDENTS.
- IT ALLOWS US TO DETERMINE IF A CHILD NEEDS ENGLISH LANGUAGE INSTRUCTIONAL SERVICES.
- AND IF SO, AT WHAT LEVEL. THE TESTS WERE DEVELOPED BY THE WIDA CONSORTIUM.

The Purpose Of WIDA Testing:

- 1. The ACCESS helps students and families understand students' current level of English language proficiency.
- 2. It serves as one of multiple measures used to determine whether students are prepared to exit English language support programs.
- 3. It generates information that assists in determining whether ELLs have attained the language proficiency needed to participate meaningfully in content area classrooms without program support.
- 4. It provides teachers with information they can use to enhance instruction and learning in programs for their English language learners.
- 5. It provides districts and Schools with information to help them evaluate the effectiveness of their ESL / Multi-lingual programs.




